RULES AND REGULATIONS –

1. Exhibitors must be enrolled in clothing or related craft project. Exhibitor should be sure exhibit is entered in appropriate class and department. If you have questions, consult with the superintendent.
2. Exhibit must have been made since September 1, 2025
3. Exhibits must be brought for judging on hangers.
4. Exhibitors in the Clothing Department CAN bring guide sheets or instructions for all clothing, knitting and crocheting exhibits. Exhibitor's name should be on guide sheet that will be returned to the exhibitor following judging.
5. Exhibitors may enter only one (1) item per class in correct age division.
6. All entry tags must be secured to item (not hanger) by safety pin, cord or rubber band.
7. Machine-made buttonholes are acceptable in tailored garments.
8. All clothing exhibits must be completely hand or machine sewing by exhibitor except for knitting and crocheting classes.
9. All exhibits must be clean and pressed appropriately.
10. Premiums – Class Champion \$5., Blue Award \$4.; Red Award - \$3.75; White Award \$3.50
