

DEPARTMENT – I-23 – Silk & Dried Florals

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Exhibitors in the Silk & Dried Florals Department must be enrolled in a plant-type project or be a member of the 4-H Horticulture Club or in floral design in the vocational-ag program to enter this department.

Entries must be completed online at www.carrollcountyfair.com. Entry fees need to be paid by credit card only. No late entries will be accepted.

Due to proposed Maryland budgetary constraints that are beyond the control of the Carroll County 4-H/FFA Fair Board, Inc., the Board reserves the right to withhold a portion of premium monies, up to and including all of an exhibitors earned premium payment, for the Carroll County 4-H/FFA Fair.

Rules and Regulations

1. All entry tags are to be securely attached to containers.
2. Accents of treated material may be used in arrangements, corsages, bud vase, and wreaths. Accents may be used such as birds, bows, etc. – they may be secondary but not the focal point of the exhibit.
3. All exhibitors are responsible to see that their exhibits are removed to receive their premiums.
4. Exhibitors may enter only one exhibit in each class.
5. All arrangements, corsages, and wreaths must contain at least 50% flowers.
6. Definitions – Dry Material – any material that has moisture removed. Treated Material – dried plant material that has been altered by glycerinizing, painted and/or bleaching. Corsage – ribbon and other accents are permitted. Line arrangement – bases its precepts upon a line. Most common lines are the shape of an “L” or “S”. Must be in a container.
7. We discourage the use of valuable containers for arrangements. While reasonable care will be taken, neither the Silk & Dried Floral Department nor the Carroll Co. 4-H & FFA Fair are responsible for valuable containers if lost, stolen or broken.
8. Premiums – Class Champion - \$5; Blue Award - \$4; Red Award - \$3.75; White Award - \$3.50
