RULES AND REGULATIONS – WOODWORKING DEPARTMENT

*****PLEASE check class descriptions carefully before entering. If you have questions, please call superintendent.*****

1. Due to space limitations, it may be necessary to exhibit large articles such as picnic tables, work benches, etc., outside the regular exhibit area.
2. Plans or blueprints should accompany exhibits for the Carroll Co. 4-H & FFA Fair.
3. All classes are for exhibits made of wood. EXHIBITS being evaluated on metal craftsmanship must be shown in Mechanical Arts Department.
4. All kits must be entered in the “kits” classes.
5. Kits – are defined as an exhibit assembled or made from pre-cut pieces of wood whether it is a commercially purchased kit or the exhibits are pre-cut for a workshop and then assembled by the 4-H or FFA member.
6. Restored, repaired, or refinished items – you must include “before” and “after” pictures with your exhibit. If pictures are not presented at the time of judging, the exhibit will be judged but appropriate point cuts will be made.
7. In class 13, – exhibitors may enter two exhibits; ALL OTHER CLASSES, exhibitors may enter only one exhibit.
8. Premiums – Class Champion - \$5; Blue Award - \$4; Red Award - \$3.75; White Award – \$3.50
