### **RULES AND REGULATIONS – Automotive Contest**

1. Only youth with driver's license may participate in the Contest.
2. Youth must have NO POINTS on their driver's license to participate in the automotive contest.
3. Contest includes – a written test of information available from 4-H automotive project materials available at the 4-H Office and MVA's Driving Instruction Manual; trouble-shooting practical exam; driving test consisting of driving through narrow openings, alley docking, weaving in and out of pegs both reverse and forward, and parallel parking.
4. In the event that the state restores the statewide contest, Youth who have previously won in the statewide contest may not represent Carroll County in future statewide events but may still continue to compete in the county competition.
5. Premiums – 1st - \$10, 2nd - \$9, 3rd - \$8, 4th - \$7, 5th - \$6, all below - \$5
