RULES AND REGULATIONS – Parade Department

1. Floats and marching units will assemble according to the number assigned.
2. There will be three judges on the Finch Stage. In order to be judged, narration must be received no later than July 21st. NO EXCEPTIONS!!!
3. Participants must stay in parade formation until completion of the parade route or no placings.
4. Each entry must prepare a narration to be read during the Contest. These narrations (75 – 100 words) should be typed or printed on the form included in the Premium List. If the narration is longer it will be cut due to the length of the parade and in consideration of the other participants.
5. LATE NARRATIONS WILL NOT BE ACCEPTED. If the club's narration is received after July 21st the club may still participate in the parade; however, parade entry WILL NOT be judged and no premiums will be paid.
6. Each entry will be directed to stop in front of the judges stand to allow judges adequate time for scoring and then each entry will then be directed out of the ring.
7. Each club/group is responsible for cleaning up the “parade formation” area assigned to them. Any group not complying will forfeit any awards and premiums. (Do not leave anything behind – this includes straw, trash, etc.)
8. Each 4-H entry must display the Affirmative Action Statement “4-H Is Open To All” and be easily visible to the judges.
9. Entries will be judged based on the Danish System. Champions will be awarded in each class.
10. Premiums – Class Champion - \$30; Blue Award - \$25; Red Award - \$20; White Award - \$15
