## **RULES AND REGULATIONS – Arc-Welding Contest**

- 1. Contest open to youth ages 11 thru 18 as of January 1 of the current year.
- 2. This contest will consist of three elements a written examination, and a welding-skills event.
- 3. Each participant must bring his or her own long-sleeved work-type shirt, welding gloves, helmet, and safety glasses to wear and pliers or tongs to handle the hot metal during the "hands-on" welding skills activity.
- 4. Groups of participants will be assigned welding times by the Superintendent(s) according to the event listing provided from the entry form. All out-of-county participants will follow the assigned numbers and times. Adults accompanying out-of-county participants may be asked to assist with running elements of the contest.
- 5. For safety reasons, only participating contestants, judges, and officials are permitted in the welding area during competition.
- 6. Designated judges and superintendent(s) will preside over the contest, and their decisions will be final. Contestants must abide by the rules and regulations. Any judge can disqualify a contestant because of unsafe practices or acts unbecoming a 4-H member.
- 7. Premiums 1st \$10, 2nd \$9, 3rd \$8, 4th \$7, 5th \$6, all below \$5
