- Judging will take place 9:00 - 11:00 am. Senior exhibits will be open for viewing after 11:30 am. Items will remain on display at the 4-H Fair until 11:00 am, Friday, August 4, 2023. Items not picked up between 12:00 - 1:00 pm, will be taken to the Bureau of Aging & Disabilities - 125 Stoner Avenue, Westminster - to be picked up beginning Monday, August 7, 2023. (Pre-registered items will be returned to the senior center where registered.) The Bureau of Aging & Disabilities will not assume responsibility for broken or lost items.
- Coordinated through the Carroll County Bureau of Aging & Disabilities.
 - This department offers the opportunity for Carroll County citizens age 60 and over to exhibit in the classes listed below.
 - Exhibitors in the SCD are not required to be a member of a Senior Center.
