

August 4, 2022 ATV DIRT DRAG RULES AND REGULATIONS

<u>Schedule:</u>

- Gates Open @ 5:30pm
- Mandatory Drivers Meeting at the starting line @ TBD
- Racing Begins @ 6:30pm
- Grudge Racing After Featured Races (Time Permitting)

<u>Classes:</u>

- 1. Stock 2 & 4 Stroke Dirtbike's 250cc & Up
- 2. Stock 2 & 4 Stroke ATV/ Sport Utility 300cc & Up
- 3. Utility ATV's & UTV's (Naturally Aspirated)
- 4. Open (Turbo's, Modified)

Class Details:

- Dirtbike's, ATV's & UTV's
 - Factory engine, transmission, drive-line, suspension and frame
 - Aftermarket intakes, exhaust, jet kits, tuners, sprockets, shocks are allowed
 - +2 swing arm and a-arms allowed, anything over +2 will be placed in "open" class
 - **NO** wheelie bars, straps or tie-downs
- Open
 - OEM frame/ can be modified, <u>NO</u> drag frames
 - Engine, transmission, drive-line and suspension modifications are allowed
 - Any length swing arm and a-arms allowed
 - Wheelie bars, straps or tie-downs allowed

Class Winner Payouts:

1st - \$100

- 2nd \$80
- 3rd \$60

Clothing Requirements:

- 1. All driver's must wear DOT approved full coverage helmet that meets FMVSS 218 specifications or higher.
- 2. Chin straps must be strapped.
- 3. All driver's must wear either eye goggles or full face shield while racing. (unless you wear prescription glasses)
- 3. Long pants and long sleeves.
- 4. Closed toe shoes (leather boots preferred)

General Rules:

- 1. All competitors planning to race must register and pay the \$20.00 entry fee.
- 2. No refund after event has started.
- 3. All participants must be 18 years of age or older and registered for event in order to compete.
- 4. Current and valid Photo ID (provisional or driver's license) is required for all participants.
- 5. All competitors participate at their own risk to themselves and their equipment.
- 6. All participants are required to read, understand and sign the rules, regulations and liability wavier forms.
- 7. Only the participant and their machine is permitted in pit area and staging lanes.
- 8. Participants will be given a number during registration that needs to be placed on the left side of machine so that officials, announcer and fans will be able to identify the driver.
- 9. No drugs or alcohol permitted
- 10. All participants are subject to breathalyzer testing at any time during event. Results from testing can result in disqualification and escorted from event with no refund or payout.
- 11. All machines are subject to inspection or testing by race officials at any time prior to, during or after the event.
- 12. All machines racing must be in safe operating condition, such as but not limited to engine, drive-line, brakes, tires, suspension, etc.
- 13. Any machine found to be unsafe or not meet class requirements can result in disqualification from event with no refund or payout.
- 14. All manufacture safety and warning labels must be present and legible.
- 15. Race officials may accept or deny any machine entered into the event.

- 16. Any decisions or calls made by race officials are final. Any arguing can result in disqualification and escorted from event with no refund or payout.
- 17. Air horns will be issued to race officials. If horn is sounded, all movement & engines stop.
- 18. No machines leave pit area until event starts.
- 19. <u>NO PIT RIDINGI</u> If caught you will be disqualified without warning and asked to leave event with no refund or payout.
- 20. Only ONE person per machine, per race.
- 21. Seat belts/ harnesses are to be worn at all times; tether kill switches highly recommended but not mandatory on ATV's/ Dirtbike's.
- 22. No nitrous oxide (NOS) or alcohol-based fuel is permitted. Petroleum-based fuel only may be used. Any extra fuel must be carried in approved containers.
- 23. No studs, screws, chains or traction adders on tires will be permitted.
- 24. Participants are **NOT** permitted on starting line until authorized.
- 25. Machines are <u>NOT</u> permitted anywhere but in authorized areas. There will be a zero tolerance if caught riding around unauthorized areas and will result in immediate disqualification with no refund or payout.
- 26. No speeding, unsafe operations or stunt riding is permitted. Anyone operating their machine on or off the track in an unsafe manner can result in disqualification from the event with no refund or payout.

27. SPEED LIMIT IS IDLE SPEED ONLY!

- 28. Must have at least 3 machines to make event class.
- 29. All races will be started by pre-stage pro tree.
- 30. Red light will be automatic loss, double red situation the loss goes to whoever red lit first.
- 31. Winner will be determined visually by a race official.
- 32. Two side by side lanes 100 ft long with 200 ft stop.
- 33. All feature event classes will be single elimination.
- 34. Participants are to stay with their machines during the class they are entered in. Failure to stay with machine can result in disqualification with no refund or payout.
- 35. Participants will have 2 minutes to get to the starting line once name is called. If not able to make it to starting line in the given time it will be counted as a loss race.
- 36. Failure to control machine or come to a safe stop will result in immediate disqualification with no refund or payout.
- 37. Crossing of any lane lines will be a loss for that race.
- 38. Winners from their classes will return to the staging lanes immediately in order to receive staging instructions for next race.

Grudge Races: (Time Permitting)

- 1. Grudge racing will take place immediately following the last featured event class.
- 2. Grudge races will cost \$5 per machine CASH ONLY (All proceeds go to charity)
- 3. Sign-up sheet will be made available and accessible prior to and during event. Cut off for sign-up will depend on number of participants and time.
- 4. Race order will follow sign-up sheet order.
- 5. No prize money will be rewarded.
- 6. Grudge racer's will be able to call out anyone from any class.
- 7. Racer called out has choice to agree or deny race. (don't feel pressured that you have to race)
- 8. Only competitors from featured events are able to participate in grudge races.
- 9. Competitors are **NOT** expected to or required to participate in grudge racing.
